

Rules for the RS Class Association RS100, RS300, RS400, RS500, RS600, RS700, RS800 and RS Vareo Rooster National Tour and RS200 Rooster Championship Tour 2026

The Rooster National Tour 2026 and RS200 Championship Tour 2026 will include the events as listed on each class-specific website calendar.

Series scores for the Rooster National Tour 2026 and RS200 Rooster Championship Tour 2026 will accrue to a helm. Crews may change from event to event. Only event scores accrued by the same helm will count towards the Rooster National Tour 2026 and RS200 Rooster Championship Tour 2026.

Each helm's event score will be equal to their final overall position for that event. For events where a helm does not obtain a final position, they will be awarded an event score equal to the number of qualifying helms in the series plus one, as per DNC rule. If a helm has final position for any event in a series, they shall be scored for the whole series.

A helm's total series score will be the sum of their event scores, excluding their worst event scores, according to the following table:

*RS300 – must enter the Nationals or Inlands to qualify for a prize

*RS500 – Nationals non-discardable

If a there is a series-score tie between two or more helms, they shall be ranked in order of their event scores from the final event. Any remaining ties shall be broken by using the tied helms' scores in the next-to-last event and so on until all ties are broken. These scores shall be used even if some of them are excluded scores.
